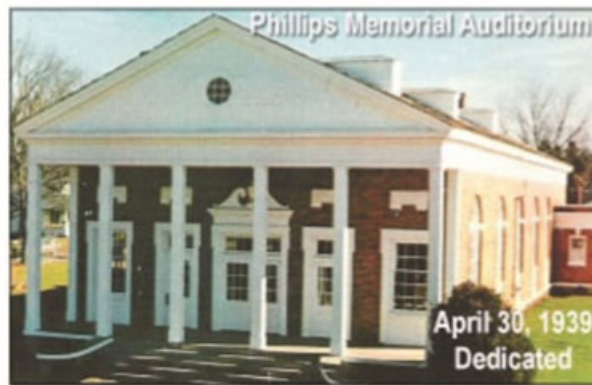


## MOVING FORWARD

The Lincolnite Club, Inc. holds/sponsors a biennial reunion every two years to continue the legacy of Lincoln School, as well as maintain Phillips Memorial Auditorium and the Classroom Addition Building, including the Lincoln Memorial Museum. Means and ways are also pursued to restore and rehabilitate the historic Lincoln High School Gymnasium as a multipurpose community center.

As of 2020, the historic Lincoln School campus will be the location for biennial Lincolnite reunions that will be hosted by Lincolnite Chapters or designated Lincolnite at large groups. The Lincolnite Chapters are namely: **Birmingham, Alabama; Chicago, Illinois; Northeast Ohio / Cleveland, Ohio; Detroit Michigan; Fort Wayne, Indiana; Gary, Indiana; Marion, Alabama; and Los Angeles, California** (now in-active).
